HOE-DOWN SQUARE DANCE

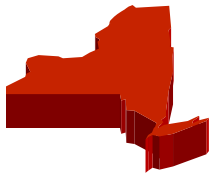

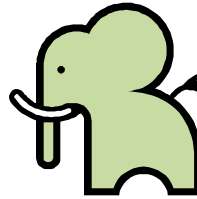

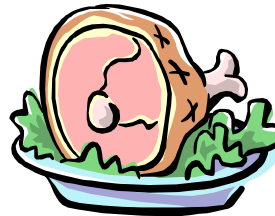
