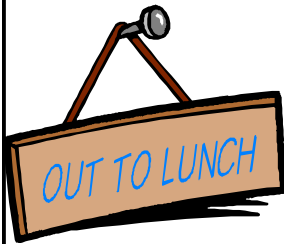

CHRISTMAS CAROLS

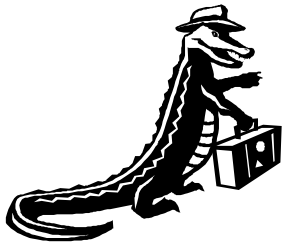

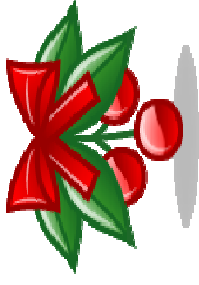
