MANAGEMENT CORNER

GOLF CARTS

Our insurance company is requiring us to verify that owners of golf carts have insurance for them. A copy of your current Certificate of Liability must be on file at the office. Golf carts are considered a vehicle and will require a sticker just like your vehicle. The person operating the golf cart must be a licensed driver. Golf carts must have lights for night use. There should never be more people riding in a golf cart, than actual seating capacity allows for. Please remember that the maximum speed limit in the park is 10 MPH whether you are driving a car or a golf cart.

PET OWNERS

Your pets need to be on a short leash and under control at all times when they are out of your unit. There have been close calls with dogs and vehicles because they were on a long leash. We don't want anyone getting hurt. Kindly clean up after your pets when you are walking them.

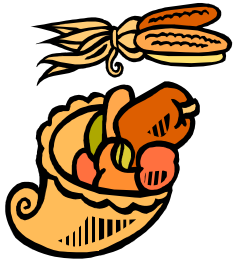
