Thursdays—Total Body Conditioning—Define and refine muscles with kickboxing & toning bands. **Bring water & mat.**

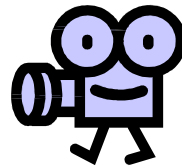
Fridays—World Rhythm—A fusion fitness workout that combines Latin Dance moves & Hip Hop Jive.

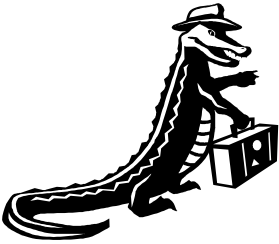
