MANAGEMENT CORNER

MAINTAINING FLOWER GARDENS IN THE RV SECTION

We make every effort to maintain this park so we have a place we can all be proud of. If you have planted a flower garden around your place, it is your responsibility to make arrangements for someone to maintain it in your absence. Please let the office staff know who will be taking care of it for you. You will be charged by the park if we have to hire someone to maintain your flowers. There is a possibility your flowers may be damaged when the mowing and trimming is done around your unit.

PREPARING FOR THE SUMMER AND HURRICANE SEASON

- Take in all rugs and mats. Mower blades love to eat them. Any rugs/mats left out will be disposed of.
- Make sure decorative/stepping stones are level with the ground, otherwise we cannot mow over them.
- All planters or decorations should be stored inside for the summer. Once they blow into your neighbors' yard, we can't identify whose they are. June 1 is the beginning of hurricane season and we don't want to have flying debris cause damage to any unit.
- Make sure you put your grill, lawn chairs, ladders, etc. inside before you leave.
- You will also want to put your awnings down before going north. It gets hectic here if we are preparing for a hurricane and all your help is appreciated.
- Make sure you get permission from the owner before you store your vehicle, boat, golf card, etc. in their carport.
