We encourage you to sign up early for trips so you won't be left behind. Sign up in the office Monday—Saturday or at coffee hours on Wednesdays.

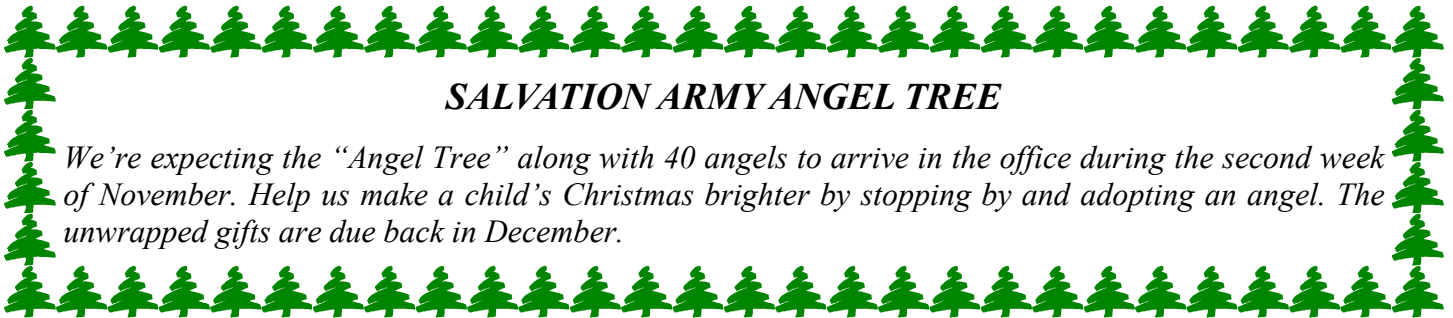
MANAGEMENT CORNER

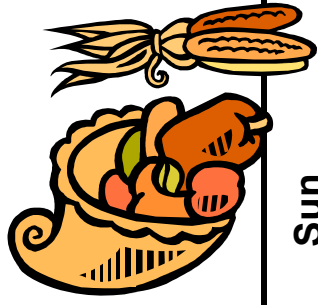

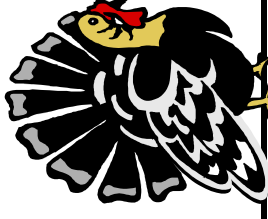
