Advanced line dancing with Char Zoscak begins **Monday, January 7th, at 10:00 a.m.** in the Club House.

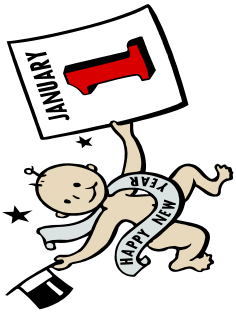
EXERCISES

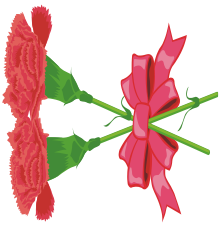
Mondays—Kombat Cardio—a combination of aerobic kickboxing with the use of hand weights.
