- **February 24—Annual Church Meeting at 5:00 p.m.** in the Club House. Detail will be given at Church.

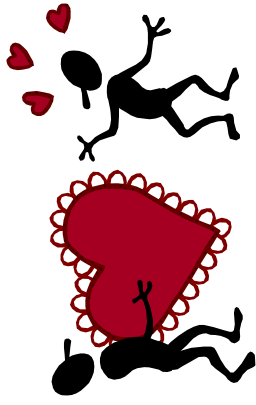


RED HATS


