ACTIVITIES

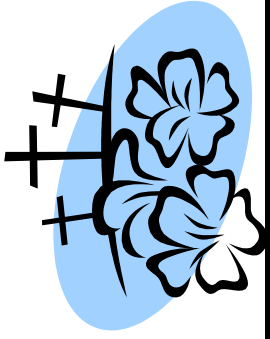
