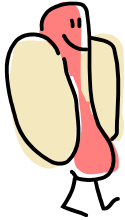

SWEET & SALTY SOCIAL

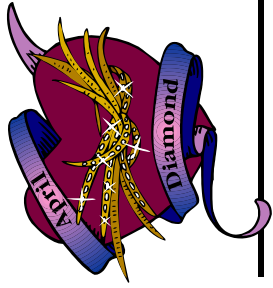
