GIRLS MOVIE/MALL DAY

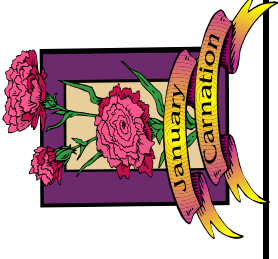



ACTIVITIES
